Code of Conduct for Student-Athletes & Coaches

Responsibilities and guidelines for athletes and coaches participating in an athletic contest that involves an extended (overnight) field trip.

Code of Conduct for Athletes:

1. There will be no use of any form of alcoholic beverages.
2. There will be no use of tobacco products.
3. There will be no use of drugs in any form unless prescribed by physician.
4. Athletes will not engage in any sexual activity.
5. All curfews and bed checks will be adhered to as set by the supervisor/coach in charge.
6. Athletes are responsible for their conduct in regard to public property such as: hotel rooms, transportation vehicles, fields and courts, locker rooms, etc.
7. Athletes must use transportation authorized by the Center Moriches Public School District.
8. There will be no gambling of any kind.
9. No visitors will be permitted in athlete's room without permission of coach/supervisor.
10. Athletes agree to comply with the Code of Conduct as adopted by the Board of Education.
11. There will be no hazing of any kind or display of mistreatment to fellow teammates.

General Guidelines:

1. All athletes should be supervised by a coach and there will be no sightseeing or traveling on their own.
2. All athletes are under the direct supervision of the coach. He/she should always know where the athletes are and who is with them.
3. Dress for all trips should be neat, clean and socially acceptable. Athletes are representing their school as well as the Center Moriches Public School District. All actions reflect on these institutions.

Coaches/Supervisors Responsibilities:

1. Enforce Code of Conduct for athletes. Discipline violation on the spot.
2. Set curfews and bed checks and implement them.
3. Be totally responsible for athletes from departure point of trip until trip is completed.
4. Conduct room checks and inspection of hotel room with occupants of each room prior to the night's stay. Any damage will be the responsibility of the occupants of the room.
5. Be responsible for making proper eating arrangements for athletes.
6. Athlete Supervision: Coaches are responsible for their teams and charges. All athletes will be actively supervised at all times. This includes hotels, locker rooms, transportation, and free time activities.
7. Supervisors/coaches must ride transportation provided by the school.
8. Notify the proper authorities (Principal, Athletic Director, etc.) in cases of serious injuries to any athlete.
9. If an athlete has to be transported to a hospital, have a representative of the school district ride with them.

Violation-Penalties:

If a student-athlete violates an established rule, the coach/supervisor in charge has the responsibility for contacting the building principal and athletic director immediately.

1. If the violation is prior to the contest/event, the athlete will not be permitted to compete in the contest or further contests, and the building principal must be notified in order to take further disciplinary action.
2. If the violation is after the contest/event, the building principal must be notified in order to take disciplinary action.
3. If any situation has been deemed a serious violation, the parent will be notified immediately, and arrangements will be made for the parents to come to the site and transport the athlete home at the parents expense.
4. All rules and regulations governing student behavior extend to all field trips, and if there are any violations of these rules, the student will be subject to the same penalties.
